- » (Website) Crowd data threshold alerting updated with the option to only receive alerts at the start and end of the coverage event.
- » (Website) Street names editable for waypoints within new/edit route.
- » (Website) Latitude/Longitude points editable for waypoints within new/edit route.
- » (Website) "Cancel" button in new/edit route.
- » (Website) Trip details displayed on the User Trips page when a trip is selected.
- » (App) Auto-retry for trips save failures.
